Thank you for your interest in the position of Specialist Mental Health Teacher. This position is based at Kenepuru Hospital in Porirua. The successful teacher may also be required to teach at other CRHS sites from time to time.

The team of specialist teachers is led by an Assistant Principal, who manages a cluster of sites at the hospital, known collectively as Te Whare o Rangituhi, as well as services based in central Wellington and the Hutt Valley. I am based in Central Wellington along with the administration centre for the school.

Teachers in the specialist mental health strand of Central Regional Health School work alongside mental health clinicians, local education services and students' schools to provide full-time individualised teaching and learning programmes for groups of young people within these services. School hours and term dates coincide with the secondary school year. We aim for students to transition successfully back to their school, or on to tertiary learning opportunities or a vocational pathway.

Experienced teachers with strong curriculum skills, high levels of independence and professionalism, successful experience collaborating in diverse teams, and the ability to adapt rapidly to the changing needs of each student will be well suited to this position.
